

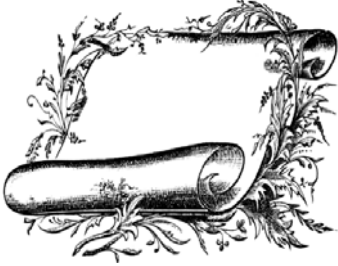

**REWARDS** *Shining Days every 5 weeks, Merit Awards*



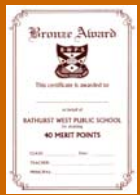
**GOLD LEVEL** 80 merit points

## **BEHAVIOUR LEVELS**

**ORANGE LEVEL** *Why - breaking school rules and/or serious misbehaviour*

**CONSEQUENCES**

- orange note to parent/caregiver
- one day of detention
- reflection sheet
- merit awards paused

**REDEMPTION** one week with no offence go to green launch level

**CONTINUED MISBEHAVIOUR** Blue Level

**BLUE LEVEL** *Why - three orange level entries in a term and/or serious misbehaviour*

**CONSEQUENCES**

- letter and parent interview
- three days of detention
- reflection sheet
- behaviour monitoring card
- miss out on classroom privileges for one week
- attendance at excursions/performances will be subjected to individual assessment
- individual assessment to represent the school
- excluded from Shining Day
- merit awards paused

**REDEMPTION** two weeks with no offence go to green launch level

**CONTINUED MISBEHAVIOUR** Purple Level

**PURPLE LEVEL** *Why - serious misbehaviour, continual misbehaviour at blue level  
- Principal or Assistant Principal decision -*

**CONSEQUENCES**

- parent interview - Assistant Principal and Classroom Teacher
- five days of detention
- reflection sheet
- two weeks on behaviour cards classroom/playground
- miss out on classroom privileges for two weeks
- one day alternate program
- alternate playground arrangements
- attendance at excursions/performances will be subjected to individual assessment
- unable to represent the school
- excluded from Shining Day
- merit awards paused

**REDEMPTION** two weeks with no offence go to green launch level

**RED LEVEL** *Suspension (short/long)  
Short up to four days and long up to and including twenty days*

**CONSEQUENCES**

- return to school meeting
- return to school plan
- two weeks on behaviour cards classroom/playground
- attendance at excursions/performances will be subjected to individual assessment
- unable to represent the school
- excluded from Shining Day
- risk assessment (long suspension only)
- merit awards paused

**REDEMPTION** two weeks with no offence go to green launch level
