Hat Policy

Cancer Council NSW recommends sun protection, including the wearing of sun-safe hats, whenever the UV is 3 or above. Most parts of NSW experience high levels of UV radiation all year round. Short periods of exposure to UV radiation are more efficient at producing Vitamin D than long or intense periods of exposure. Long periods in the sun do not improve Vitamin D levels but increase the risk of skin damage and skin cancer.

Following this recommendation, Bathurst West Public School students will now be required to wear school hats outside in all terms. On particularly cold days, it is acceptable for students to wear a maroon beanie.

Asbestos

Late last term, some suspicious pieces of material were found by Barry in our top playground area which we were concerned might be asbestos. The Department of Education and our school now begin a coordinated response to this following very strict protocols. This includes excavation and removal by a fully qualified asbestos removal company, air quality monitoring and independent certification of the site's safety once the work is complete.
